I stayed friends with through to the 6th form and I left school at the end of the 6th form.

We remain friends.

did get into a bit of trouble at school and missed quite a lot of classes in the 6th form.

I have seen Mr BENSON-POPE a few times, he has come into the shop on the odd occasion.

It would be better for me and I would rather bully shit that nothing happened, and it would be such a long time ago I doubt that BENSON-POPE would remember it happening.

He used to keep an eye on what was happening at school, and watch for trouble, he did give out a few detentions I believe, but I thought he was doing an excellent job at school.
