

Free ECE Monthly Monitoring Report: services, enrolments and advances

Date: 26 June 2007

This report is based on services' applications for advances for Free ECE, as recorded in their RS3 and EC20 applications. As such, it does not include services which have not applied for advance funding and Kohanga Reo services.

This report gives: -the number and proportion of eligible services intending to offer Free ECE
 -the estimated number of Free ECE enrolments and what they are as a proportion of all 3-4 year old enrolments in eligible services
 - the amount of funding advanced for Free ECE.
