## NDCC UPDATE

#### I. Situation Overview

- ✚ The southwest monsoon associated with heavy rains induced by Typhoon Frank triggered the occurrence of floodings, landslides, maritime incidents and power interruptions in most of the provinces of the 13 Regions affected particularly Regions VI and VIII.
- ✚ There were 19 road network rendered impassable to all types of vehicles due to collapsed or washed-out, cut off roadway section and bridge approaches, road slips, collapsed roadslide structures, washed-out both approaches and eroded both sides, breakdown as follows: 7 in Region IV-B; 9 in Region VI and 3 in Region VIII.
- ✚ Eleven (11) other maritime incidents occurred at the height of Typhoon Frank with **8 dead, 23 missing and 57 survivors**. The names of vessel and fishing boats are: MV Lake Paoay, Fishing boat Meme, F/B Nicole-Louise, F/B Angel Sweet I, F/B Ludith, MV Princess of the Seas, MV Sta Bernadetta, MV Ocean Papa, MV Delfin OTSO MV Kinscebu and M/L Katarena,

#### II. Summary of Disaster Impact as of 6:00 PM 28 June 2008

- ✚ Population Affected - As of this report the total number of affected population is **638,840 families / 3,216,039 persons** affected in **4,596** barangays, **366** municipalities and **47** cities in **48** provinces of **15** Regions
- ✚ Population served both inside and outside the evacuation centers were **402,231** families / **2,113,361** persons. **Details in Tab A**
- ✚ Casualties - There were **540 persons reported dead (328 identified 212 recovered bodies), 175 injured and 41 missing** in Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, X, XI, XII, ARMM and CARAGA. **Details in Tab B-1**

- ✚ There were **248,267** houses damaged **67,932** totally and **180,335** partially. Details on Tab C
- ✚ The estimated cost of damage to infrastructure and agriculture in Regions 1, 3, 4-A, 4-B, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, ARMM, and NCR is **Php 7,317,188,568.21** broken down as follows: **Infrastructure: Roads and Bridges – Php 1,573,717,500; School Buildings/ Classrooms – Php 518,679,300.00, Other Facilities – Php 9,950,000.00; and Agriculture – Php 5,214,841,768.21.** Details on Tab D.

### III. Summary of National/ Regional/ LGUs Responses

- ✚ NDCC –OPCEN facilitated all requests for assistance in terms of rice, transport, equipment, rubber boats, cadaver bags, food and non food items to appropriate member agencies and transport of same Iloilo and Aklan Provinces to support current search and rescue, relief and recovery efforts being conducted by the LGUs ithereat.
- ✚ The estimated cost of assistance provided by the NDCC, DSWD, DepEd, LGUs and NGOs amounted to **Php 38,648,253.20** broken down as follows: **NDCC (Php 14,289,750.00), DSWD (Php 12,201,349.41), LGUs (Php 9,562,023.79) and NGOs (Php 2,595,130.00).** Details on Tab E
- ✚ **NDCC/RDCCs/PDCCs** facilitated the release of **15,660** sacks of rice for Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, XII, NCR and ARMM to augment relief operations of the LGUs.

### Summary of Airlift Operation

- ✚ A total of six (6) C-130 sorties have been made by PAF from June 22 to 26, 2008. A total of **153,165 lbs** of relief items were ferried to Iloilo and Aklan amounting to **P5,924,326.09** broken down as follows:
  - Food items - ready –to-eat food; compact food, family food packages used
  - NFIs - water jugs, used clothing, water purifier, detergent powder and medical supplies, bed sheets
  - Equipment - water purifier and 5 rubber boats intended for PDCCs Iloilo Aklan; Capiz, Antique) and CDCC Iloilo City
- ✚ PAF Poker Plane departed early this morning for Iloilo carrying 1,425 lbs of assorted goods (medicines, mineral water and sacks of bread) intended for Iloilo and 5,980 lbs of assorted goods and clothing intended for Roxas City with the Secretary of National Defense and OCD Administrator on board.
- ✚ OCD OPCEN facilitated the transport of DSWD's relief goods: family food packs and 500 packs used clothing to Marinduque through 1 6x6 M35 truck. The truck left for Marinduque at 1600H, 28 June 2008.
- ✚ **Areas Declared Under A State of Calamity**

Provinces -Albay, Antique, Iloilo, Aklan, Capiz, Sarangani, Sultan Kudarat, North Cotabato, Romblon and Marinduque

Municipalities - Paombong and Obando, Bulacan; Carigara, Leyte; Lake Sebu, Surallah, Sto. Nino and Tiboli, South Cotabato; and San Fernando, Romblon

Barangays - Nine (9) in Zamboanga City

- ✚ NDCC Cluster Meeting with Inter Agency Standing Committee (IASC) was held yesterday, 27 June 2008 at the DND Social Hall to address urgent needs and gaps in relation to the devastating effects of Typhoon Frank in various regions.

#### **Food and Shelter Cluster**

- ✚ The DSWD as the lead of food and shelter clusters presented to the IASC the following priorities for funding assistance

##### **Food - 49,738 families**

Region IV-A - Quezon 10,099 families

Region VI - Iloilo 8,937 families; Capiz 8,715 families; Negros Occidental 7,015 families; and Antique 5,947 families

Region VIII - Tacloban City 654 families ;

Region XII - North Cotabato 1,451 families and Sultan Kudarat 5,060 families

ARMM - Maguindanao 1,000 families

Region IX - Zamboanga del Sur 860 families

##### **Shelter - 50,752 totally damaged and 76,984 partially damaged**

Region VI - Iloilo 18,424 totally and 7152 partially

##### **Suggested Package for Assistance**

Food - family food packs, ready-to-eat food, rice and pulses

Drinking Water

Clothing - children's clothes, underwears and assorted clothings

Household Items - cooking utensils, dining utensils, toiletries, blankets, sleeping mats, mosquito repellent, baby diapers, water containers/jug

Lighting supplies - flashlights with batteries, candles, gas lamps

Emergency Shelter Assistance – (ESA) P5,000.00 /family, construction materials, and family tents

Care Shelter Assistance program –P70, 000.00 /family/unit

Cash/Food for Work (C/FFW) – P200.00/family/day x 10 days

##### **Education Cluster**

- ✚ DepEd reported the following:

- 61,456 school children and 1,451 teachers were affected in ARMM.
- the priority needs of children is replacement of damaged school supplies and books
- 981 school buildings were damaged amounting to P476, 229,300.00

- Around 138 school buildings have been used as evacuation centers of 3,148 families
- 135 learning centers in 13 DCCs; 114 schools and 8 Madrasahs are being used as evacuation centers
- DepEd Engineering Task Forces in various regions are conducting actual inspection of damages
- Coordinations with local government, brgy officials and PTCAs for the clearing operations and repair of minor damages of school buildings and facilities are on going
- Save the Children raised 15,000 US \$ for emergency/relief assistance for Iloilo and Antique and currently conducting field assessment
- UNICEF initially sent 2,000 school packs, 500 teachers packs, 5 tents(72 sq meters for 2 classrooms ) and school library sets and will conduct field assessment next week to determine further assistance
- Plan Phil is conducting field assessment in Panay Island
- ABS-CBN Foundation is conducting field assessment and relief operations in Panay and call for donation and appeal is ongoing

### **Health Cluster**

- ✚ DOH reported the following :
  - 28 health facilities were damaged in VI,VII, XII and ARMM : 26 partially and 2 totally amounting to P 32, 250,000.00
- ✚ Deployed technical experts such as : epidemiologists, psychologists, doctors, nurses and rapid health assessment , WASH and medical team distributed in the CHD VI and the four provinces of Panay Island
- ✚ Logistical support from DOH and various CHDs – drugs and medical supplies; compact food, water disinfectants, containers and purifiers , cadaver bags, generator P1 Million for MOOE from QRF with a total amount of P 6,171,149.36
- ✚ Health Needs are
  - Emergency phase – drugs and medical supplies; generators sets as requested by Region VI; water and sanitation in Region VI and VII like water purifiers, containers and disinfectant
  - Rehab phase – repair of damaged health facilities, infrastructure and equipment

### **Region V**

- ✚ OCD 5 coordinated with PRO for the availability of personnel to assist in loading water purifying machine and water bladder to the C-130 bound for Iloilo.

### **Region IV-B**

- ✚ NFA facilitated the release of 1,314 sacks of rice in Romblon, Marinduque and Oriental Mindoro.
- ✚ DILG- IV-B assisted in the distribution of rice to affected families in Romblon Province
- ✚ OCD IV-B coordinated with DSWD IV-B re delivery and distribution of relief goods to the provinces of Romblon, Mariduque and likewise, coordinated with NFA for the release of 100 sacks of rice to Sta Cruz, Marinduque and 500 sacks to Marinduque Province released by NDCC
