Attack practice around old buildings off parade ground. Washing parade in afternoon. Arrival of mail.

Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup>. First parade 7 30 am. Divisional training, marched through Helmeih, did outpost duty all day. I was on outpost from 10 am till 4 30 pm, easy day. Wrote to home in evening.

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup>. First parade 7 30 am. Batallion training, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Companies against 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> marched to near Virgins breast, attack practice advancing and retiring. Returned to camp 1 pm. Free for rest of day.

Friday 26<sup>th</sup>. First parade 9 am. Marched through Helmeih, lecture under trees by Sgt. Major Glanville. 2 pm 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Coys marched to railway line at Helmeih, wandered away in sections and inspected the town and buildings in readiness or preparation for attack next week. 8 30 pm arrival of Maori contingent, 10 pm arrival of N.Z. troops. A. Wheway received one stripe.

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup>. Tent and rifle inspection in morning. Free rest of day.

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup>. Very windy and dusty. Church parade off owing to wind and dust. Free all day. Went over to burial ground, digging for treasures, entered old tombs and holes. Had great fun with locasts coming home from tombs.

Monday 29<sup>th</sup>. Big march past, Sir Ian Hamilton, all N.Z. and Australian troops in attendance.

Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup>. Revellie 4 30 am. Divisional training, training for Red Cross and medical men, marched to other side of power house, attack practice. Returned @ 12 30 pm. Free for rest of day. Spotty and I went to Cairo, flash light photo taken (Shorts).

Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup>. First parade 6 30 am. Street fighting practice 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> versus 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. Returned to camp 10 am. Free till 7 pm when the Battalion marched through Zeitoun and around through Heliopolis, then back home through Tommies camp, arrived back 9 pm.

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April 1915. Revellie 4 am. Fall in 5 30 am. Division marched past power house then through date plantation, came out at "Marg" through native quarters and home through Helmeih and Zeitoun, arrived back at camp 11 30 am after marching about 15 or 16 miles. Free for rest of day, no water allowed on march, many on mat. Paid 136 piastres (21/-). April fools day, great fun.

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup>. Good Friday. Free all day. Big riot in Cairo many injured. Arthur Wheway arrested and put in the clink at Cairo.

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup>. Cleaning up of lines, tent inspection. No leave Cairo out of bounds.
