Figure 1: Real Gross Domestic Product (GDP)






Figure 2: Growth in Real GDP per Capita

Figure 4: Productivity Growth Rates (labour)




Figure 5: Unemployment Rate (seasonally adjusted)





Figure 6: Consumer Price Inflation and Inflation Expectations



Figure 8A: National Savings as a Percent of GDP




Figure 8B: Household Net Worth as a Percent of net disposable income






Figure 9A: New Zealand Core Crown Expenses


Figure 9B: New Zealand General Government Total Outlays (Includes local government spending and capital outlays)


Figure 10: Total Crown Balance as a percent of GDP


Figure 11: Net Permanent & Long-term Loss to Australia



Figure 1: GDP per capita in OECD Countries 2007




Figure 2: New Zealand's GNI per capita relative to the member countries of the OECD






Figure 3: Trans Tasman Per Capita Incomes Year Ended June 2008


Figure 4: Real GDP Growth per Capita Growth Rates (home currencies)


Figure 5: United Nations Human Development Index (Top 40 Countries)

(encompasses longevity, health, knowledge, and GDP per capita




