


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

I was in the lead aircraft CZ18. Prior to arrival in Zone 30 I contacted Bushmaster 06 for a situation report. Bushmaster 06 informed me that the elements on the ground had been recieving small arms and RPG fire from the east of their position and he wanted the team too search for the AIF teams. CZ 18/19 proceeded to search for AIF, CZ19 spotted approximately 10-15 AIF with weapons preparing to engage the friendly forces. I then got the AIF in my TADS and observed the individuals with AK-47's and RPG launchers. One AIF was leaning around a corner with an RPG preparing to engage friendly forces so I called Bushmaster 06 to ask for clearance of fire. 1126 who was the commander of the element receiving fire and Bushmaster 06 then gave the team clearance to fire. Both CZ18/19 engaged the AIF with approximately 200 rounds of 30mm. Team observed one wounded AIF try to crawl away and kept eyes on target to walk 1126 onto the area. CZ18/19 then observed a black minivan arrive on the scene and begin to take the wounded man into the vehicle along with some weapons. CZ18 asked for permission to engage from H26 and was granted permission to fire. CZ18/19 engaged with approximately 70 rounds of 30mm destroying the vehicle and killing the AIF. Total BDA for this engagement was 11 KIA, 3 WIA, 1xVan, and multiple AK-47's and RPG's. While team was providing security for H26 at the first engagement area H26 informed the team that they were receiving small arms fire from the S/SW and wanted to team to recon the area for AIF. CZ18 then located 5xAIF with AK-47's and 1xRPG. Team was given clearance to engage by H26. I then observed a child and some other noncombatants in the vicinity of the AIF so decided to hold off on the engagment until the non-combatants were clear. After the non-combatants were clear CZ18 the engaged the AIF with 20x30mm. There were 2 possible WIA and I observed the individuals run into a large multistory building. The team then searched the area for more AIF. CZ 19 reported a red SUV that has possible AIF in it and team followed and observed the vehicle but could not get PID on any weapons. The team then returned to the engagement area. Upon arrival I observed another AIF with an AK-47 walking too the building. When the AIF heard our rotorwash he then ran into the building the other AIF had gone into. The building was a 4 story building that looked abandoned and half finished and possibly still under construction. We then asked H26 for clearance to engage the building with hellfire missiles. 1126 granted the team clearance to fire. The team proceeded to engage the building with 3 hellfire missiles. CZ 18 fired 1xK2 and 1xN missiles, CZ 19 fired 1x N missile. There were approximately 10 AIF KIA during this engagment. Team then did BHO with CZ 03/04 because the team needed to refuel at the FARP. Team returned to the area after refuel and did another BHO with CZ03/04. I then contacted Ranger 14 for a situation report. Ranger 14 gave numerous grids for possible ambush sites and indirect fire POO's. Team conducted recon with no further sitings of AIF forces. The team then escorted the friendly elements back to FOB Rustimayha and RTB'd mission complete, no battle damage to our aircraft. I was flying trail with Pilot-In Command, CW4 (b)(6), (b)(3 Our call sign was Crazy Horse 19. Lead, Crazy Horse 18, was CW3)(6), (b)(3 Air Mission Commander and pilot, and his Co-Pilot Gunner was CW2 (6), (b) Around 1000 hrs, Attack Mike contacted Crazy Horse 03 and 04 for a Troops in Contact in Zone 30. Crazy Horse 03 and 04 were scheduled to refuel at the FARP and did not have enough station time to respond. Attack Mike passed the Troops in Contact to us. We contacted Bushmaster 06 shortly after receiving the grid and contact information from Attack Mike. Upon arriving on station in Zone 30, lead was in contact with Bushmaster H26 and Bushmaster 6. Bushmaster was conducting operation Cure and was receiving small arms and RPG fire from South of their position. At approximately 1020 hrs, I identified 3 military aged males with AK-47s and one male with an RPG, they were with 10-15 other military aged males. I was unable to determine if all of them had weapons. After viewing the gun tape, we were able to determine that several others had weapons and one AIF had a machine gun, possibly a RPK. The AIF were firing around the corner to the East towards several of Bushmasters M1114 HWWMVs near the gas station. Crazy Horse 18 received clearance of fires from Bushmaster H26. IAW the current ROE because we had witnessed the AIF firing at Coalition forces (hostile act), we did not need clearance of fires, but we had time to ask. Crazy Horse 18 initiated fire at the personnel with weapons and I engaged the same group. I fired approximately 50 rounds of 30mm. We engaged vic (b)(2)High Soon after our engagement, a van and 4-5 military aged males arrived at the engagement site and began loading personnel and weapons into the van. Bushmaster cleared us to engage the van and personnel. Crazy Horse 18 initiated fire and I fired approximately 40 rounds at the personnel and the van. We remained above the engagement site while Bushmaster sent ground forces to the site. Bushmaster arrived and reported 11 x AIF KIA and found RPGs and RPG rounds at the site. We also witnessed a loaded RPG lying 2-3 blocks south of the engagement site that had been dropped by fleeing AIF. Bushmaster found two wounded female children at the engagement site. Bushmaster reported that the first child was wounded and pulled from the van. We were unable to determine that there were children in the vehicle and never saw any children prior to or during the engagement. After reviewing the gun tape, were able to determine that both wounded children came from the van. Bushmaster immediately MEDEVACd both girls to FOB Loyalty for medical care. At approximately 1100 hours, we observed another group of military aged males about 400 meters east of Bushmaster's position, at (b)(2)High least 3 of them had AK-47s and another had a RPG. After viewing the gun tape, another AIF had a fully loaded tactical vest and machine gun. Crazy Horse 18 received clearance of fires from Bushmaster H26 and 06. There were 3 groups with 6-7 males in each group. There was a boy with one group of personnel with weapons and Crazy Horse 18 waited a few minutes waiting for the boy to leave. After the boy was clear from the group, Crazy Horse 18 fired at the personnel with weapons. I was unable to determine which group had the weapons, due to target obscuration from buildings and dust, and I did not engage. The AIF scattered into several buildings, many of them went across the street into what appeared to be a vacant building under construction at (b)(2)High The unfinished building was very large and about 3 stories tall and had construction material laying next to it and rebar sticking out of the top. I spotted 3-4 military aged males near this building get into a red SUV and drive away to the West. We reported this to Bushmaster H26 and followed the SUV for 5-10 minutes. Bushmaster was still receiving sporadic small arms fire and we returned to their position. When we returned to the building site, Crazy Horse 18 observed several of the same AIF in the street with weapons. The AIF fled into the same building. I had off tuned our radio to report to Attack Mike and begin a battle hand over with Crazy Horse 03 and 04 to allow us to return to Taji for refuel and rearm. Crazy Horse 18 told us that we were clear to engage the building with a hellfire. I am unsure who gave the clearance of fires. Around 1125 hrs, Crazy Horse 18 engaged the ground floor with a K model missile and appeared to only have knocked down the surrounding wall. We engaged the same building with a N model missile at the ground floor where we'd previously seen the AIF enter the building. Crazy Horse 18 then engaged the second floor of the building with another N model missile. After our missile engagements, we completed the Battle Hand Over with Crazy Horse 03 and 04. They continued to provide security and reconnaissance to Bushmaster while we returned to Taji to rearm and refuel. At the time of our departure to Taji, Bushmaster elements were still receiving small arms and RPG fire. We returned to Zone 30 at approximately 1220 hrs. Crazy Horse 03 and 04 told us to contact Ranger 14. Ranger 14 and Bushmaster elements were preparing to exfiltrate the area and return back to FOB Rusty. We continued to provide security and reconnaissance of several areas for suspected complex attacks that Ranger had received intel on. We did not engage any other targets after returning from the FARP. At approximately 1330, all Bushmaster elements had returned to FOB Rusty. We completed a battle hand over with Crazy Horse 10 and 11 and returned to FOB Taji, Mission Complete (b)(6)10. EXHIBIT 11. The avenues of attack, I guess for the ground guys. They said that the fires were coming from ground level, so that's why we focused on the streets and not rooftops. Did you observe or was there any knowledge of a camera man or any media being in the area? LTC CPT No sir, in fact I've never heard of anything like that before. I don't remember if we lased and stored the target. Then we sent it to lead, and got them focused in on looking at it too. LTC(b)(6), (b)(3) Good engagement with good effects on the target. Moving to the next portion of that engagement, when did you first identify the van? CPT b)(6), (b)(3 I think we made at least one or two circles around the target area and I don't remember. We got the call on our internal frequency saying something about the van. I was kind of off looking at some of the neighboring blocks and stuff like that, so I didn't notice that right away. We were up with Attack Mike giving a SITREP on the engagement that had just happened at the time the van arrived on station. LTC(b)(6), (b)(3) After you engaged the van, the situation was pretty peaceful or calm down there, despite what had just happened. Were there any additional threats to the area or did you perceive any threats to the ground forces? CPT (b)(6),(b)(3) Sometime after the engagement we got reports that the ground forces were still taking sporadic small arms fire. So we continued our search in the neighborhoods, and probably 20 or 30 minutes after our engagement we found another group of individuals with machine guns, AK47s and RPGs.
