We expect that Ian Fletcher will be keen to attend this debrief as well – and as such, we would be happy to host the debrief, if that worked for you and your seniors:

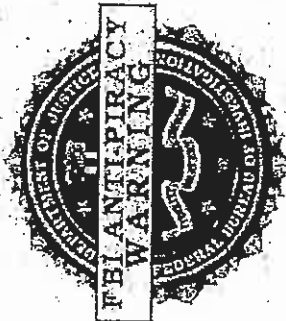

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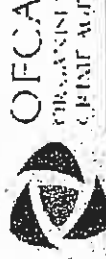
