On Saturday evening we will hear Terry Ehou's personal story, "Mate Huka, My story" and how this relates to the very successful [Ngati and Healthy programme](#). This was established on the East Cape between Ngati Porou Hauora and the Edgar National Centre for Diabetes Research to tackle the problem of diabetes in that area.

We are conscious that a major function of the Conference is Education in diabetes management, either for yourself or to be passed on to others through DNZ's branch structure.

The programme will run from 1 pm Friday 20 September to lunch on Sunday 22 September with the AGM of Diabetes New Zealand being held at 1:30 Friday afternoon. This provides the opportunity for you to have a say in the way your organisation is being run and the direction it is taking. And of course there will be sessions on establishing and confirming National Standards in the message that Branches are passing out in their catchments; and how Branches can derive maximum benefit from the annual Awareness week.
