

Pay period 19 covered the activity period 26 November to 9 December 2014. This page reports only on the complaints received by Novopay and the Ministry regarding no pays, underpayments and overpayments between 8 December to 12 December (the week of the payment for pay period 19).

Key summary metrics:

Complaints had been received from a total of 46 schools (representing 1.90% of schools in the pay roll system). Complaints relate to the pay for 70 staff from these schools (or 0.075% of the staff paid). All complaints that are detailed in this report have been or are being resolved by Novopay and the Ministry.
