We are testing a number of proposals for change to:

- »» Focus on learning progress and better achievement results for all children and young people
- »» Maintain diversity of choice for all children and young people, parents and whanau
- »» Give schools more flexibility to make decisions about how they use funding

<b>Per-child funding</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delivers more funding on a per-child basis</li> <li>• Aligns funding to learning expectations across a child's schooling journey</li> <li>• Supports learning in and through te reo Māori</li> </ul>
<b>Better supports for those most at risk</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Funding to meet the needs of children and young people most at risk of under-achievement</li> <li>• Targets resources to where they are most needed</li> <li>• Removes the stigma of school decile</li> </ul>
<b>Funding a range of school types</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensuring isolated early learning services, ngā kohanga reo and schools can provide quality teaching and learning for all kids</li> <li>• Maintaining options to attend local schools</li> </ul>
<b>Lifting performance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parents know how early learning services, ngā kohanga reo and schools are raising achievement for their kids</li> <li>• Early learning services, ngā kohanga reo and schools know what works and doesn't work for different groups of kids.</li> </ul>
<b>Global budget</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gives schools more flexibility to decide how money is used to meet the educational needs of their community</li> <li>• Making it easier to use and share resources to support all children and young people</li> <li>• Schools still able to employ the best teacher for the job</li> </ul>
<b>Property funding for schools</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Greater clarity about expenditure on property and teaching and learning</li> <li>• Ensures consistent maintenance of school property</li> <li>• Freeing up school leadership to focus on teaching and learning</li> </ul>
<b>Delivery of education options</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supporting a variety of education options for all children and young people, and their parents. Including state, state-integrated, partnership schools and private schooling.</li> </ul>
