

## PROPERTY POLL November 2016

**CLIENT**: Property Institute of New Zealand

**POLL DATES**: Mon 31 to Wed 16 November 2016. The median response was

collected on Mon 7 November 2016.

**TARGET POPULATION:** New Zealand adults.

**SAMPLE POPULATION:** New Zealand adults who are contactable on a landline.

**SAMPLE SIZE**: 1,000 respondents agreed to participate.

**SAMPLE SELECTION**: A random selection of 15,000 nationwide phone numbers.

**SAMPLE ERROR**: Based on this sample of 1,000 respondents, the maximum

sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/- 3.2%, at the 95%

confidence level.

**WEIGHTING:** The results are weighted to the NZ adult population by gender,

age and area.

**CODE COMPLIANCE:** This poll was conducted in accordance with the New Zealand

Political Polling Code, the Research Association New Zealand

Code of Practice and the International Chamber of

Commerce/European Society for Opinion and Market Research

Code on Market and Social Research.
