


Key Points

- Overall capacity is scheduled to increase 8% over last winter's schedule. Capacity is increasing in the shoulder season months for both international (May ↑20%, June ↑8%), and Domestic (April ↑15%, May ↑19%, June ↑13%).
- The peak winter week is from Monday 9 July to Sunday 15 July, with an average of 56 daily flights for this period (arrivals and departures). Peak period for the previous year was 3 July to 9 July with an average of 54 daily flights.
- The busiest days are 7 July, 14 July, 21 July and 28 July.
- Consistent with the summer season the largest increase to average flights per day in the winter season have been on Tuesdays and Thursdays with an additional 3 landings each per day all in Domestic.

Winter Peak

- The busiest days of 7 July, 14 July, 21 July and 28 July (all Saturdays) are expected to have passenger volumes in the range of 7900 8600 per day.
- · The peak winter week is from Monday 9 July to Sunday 15 July, the graph below shows the scheduled daily landings for this week.
- Flight movements over this week have a morning peak between 11-12am before the busy afternoon hours of 1 4pm.
- In comparsion to the prior year's peak week, capacity has been added in the morning peak between 11-12am, and in the evening between 6-7pm with a slight reduction in the busy afternoon hours 1-4pm.
