- International passenger volumes continued to grow in November 2007, up 2.6% over the same month last year, and up 4.1% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- International arrivals and departures were both up in November 2007 by 2.7%, and 2.5%, respectively.
- New Zealand resident arrivals were up 9.7% compared to the same period last year, and 7.3% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Major inbound markets were mixed, with Australia up 8.1%, the United Kingdom down 8.2% and the United States down 5.7%.
- Canada was up 12.9% for the month and up 5.0% on a 12 month rolling basis. Air New Zealand commenced a new service to Vancouver during November.
- Chinese arrivals were up 1.2% for the month, and up 16.8% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Japanese arrivals were down 16.4% for November 2007 and down 13.4% on a 12 month rolling basis, with Korea being down 15.6% for the month and down 8.6% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- Domestic passenger volumes were up 3.8% compared to same month last year and up 3.6% on a 12 month rolling basis.
- International aircraft movements and domestic aircraft movements increased in November by 0.6% and 5.4% respectively. Year to date international and domestic aircraft movements were down 1.3% and 3.3% respectively.
