



# Benchmark Resilience

A web-based tool for measuring and benchmarking your organisation's resilience

Organisations are part of the network that will help New Zealanders to plan for, respond to, and recover from crisis. Auckland organisations have been identified as critical to achieve resilience in New Zealand.

## 1000 Auckland organisations will benchmark their resilience

In February 2009 the Resilient Organisations Research Programme will launch the Benchmark Resilience project in conjunction with the University of Canterbury and the Auckland Civil Defence Emergency Management Group.

The aim of the project is to offer organisations a real opportunity to progress in improving their resilience and to gain a snapshot of the resilience of the Auckland region.

Organisations will be randomly selected to participate, but you can also volunteer so that your organisation can take advantage of the opportunity. Participating organisations will be able to:

- measure and benchmark their resilience against other organisations
- find out what their strongest and weakest resilience characteristics are
- compare their resilience against others in their industry (where available)
