### Research Methodology by Reid Research

<b>Date poll was conducted</b>	Interviews were conducted over the period 24th May to 31 <sup>st</sup> July , 2012
<b>Sample Size</b>	1000 voter eligible New Zealanders aged 18+
<b>Sampling Technique</b>	Telephone Interviews. Random generation of telephone numbers with quota sampling to ensure representative cross section by age, sex and geography
<b>Sample Coverage</b>	National including rural, secondary urban and main urban areas
<b>Sample Error</b>	Maximum of 3.1% expressed at a 95% confidence level (see below)

Observed Percentages	10% or 90%	20% or 80%	30% or 70%	40% or 60%	50%
Confidence limits	+/- 1.9%	+/- 2.5%	+/- 2.7%	+/- 3.0%	+/- 3.1%
