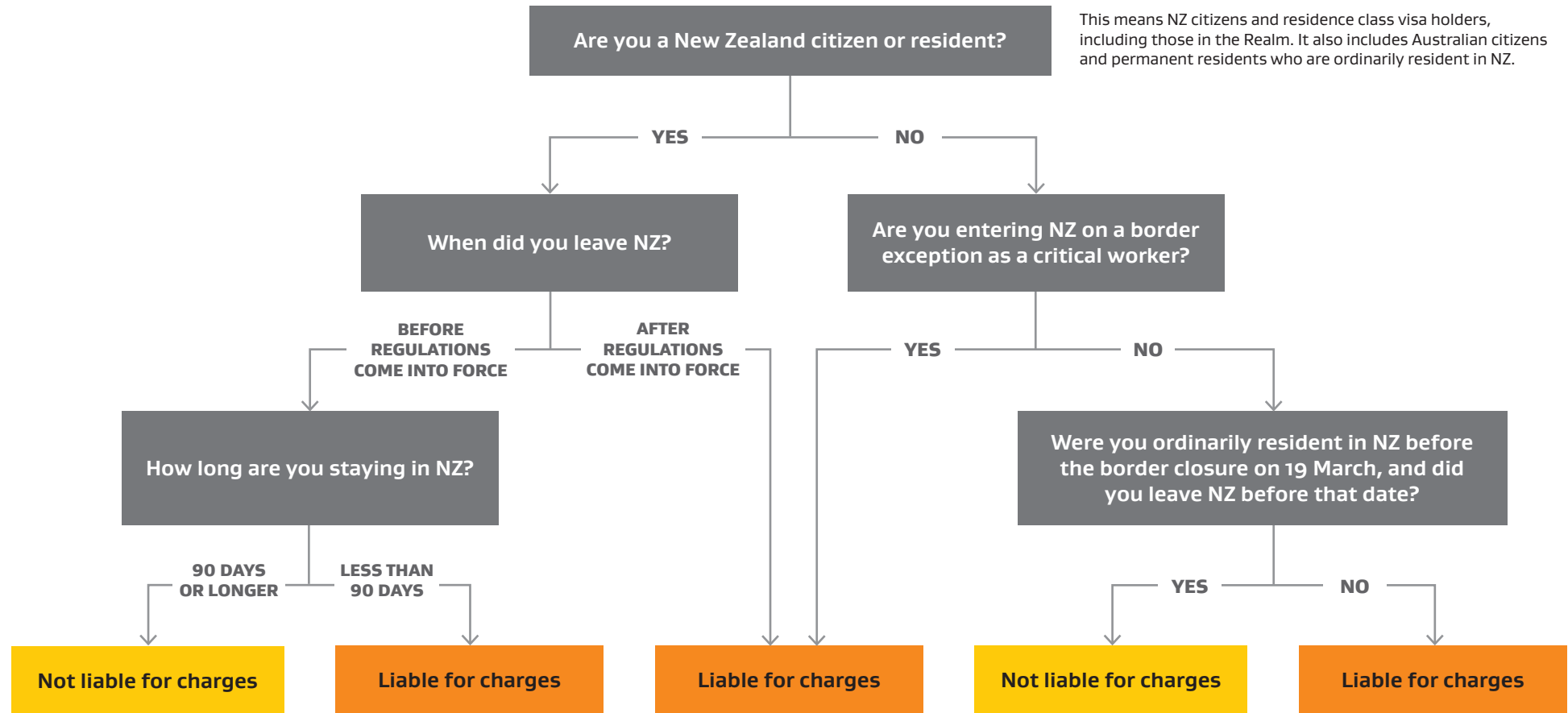


Proposed liability for managed isolation and quarantine charges



NOTES:

- › Ordinarily resident means having lived in New Zealand for 183 days (ie. six months) of the previous 12 months.
- › Anyone travelling or isolating with a family member who does not have to pay charges is also exempt from charges, unless they are entering New Zealand on a border exception as a critical worker. A family member is defined as a partner, legal guardian, and any dependent children.
- › There would be other classes of exempt people (eg. diplomats, refugees, deportees, people travelling to attend the sentencing of the accused in the Christchurch mosque attacks).
