## What is the Get Ready, Work Ready programme?

Get Ready, Work Ready aims to equip Pacific youth aged 18–24 years old in the Auckland region with employment skills to enter the workforce or into further training. The programme is funded by the Ministry of Social Development.

## When does the programme start?

Tuesday 21 March, 2023.

## Who is it for?

The Get Ready, Work Ready is for Pacific youth aged 18–24 years in the Auckland region who are not in work or education training.

## How much does the programme cost?

The programme is FREE.

## Where is the programme run?

The programme is being delivered onsite at different venues across Manukau.

## What will participants be doing in the programme?

Participants will learn transferable soft skills and obtain certified skills that will get them ready for work or further education training. These soft skills include; communication, time management, team work, drivers license, first aid, forklift license, being confident to manage money and much more. Participants will also receive continuous pastoral care as they are supported through the onboarding process, duration of the programme and continued Pastoral care support after the programme.

The programme comprises of 3 stages:

- 1. Holistic Focus** – Building strong relationships and understanding the importance of identity and culture in one's working life
- 2. Development focus** – building confidence to be 'Work Ready'
- 3. Community and employment Focus** – Community service and employment exposure
